**RE – SHORT ST TAXI BAY RELOCATION TO PASPALEY PLAZA**

Thank you for your letter dated 10<sup>th</sup> October 2018. We are in support of relocating the current Short St Taxi Rank to within the Paspaley Plaza carpark area, as shown on your supplied map, along the side of Best and Less. We may provide seating for customer comfort, and from an aesthetic view point, reticulation and pot plants at this area. The verandah will provide for a shaded and dry area all year around.

We are very aware of our customer and tenant feedback, and with this in mind have had to take that feedback on board and work hard to find a way to ensure that our customers and tenants feel safe when they are arriving and departing our centre, either by taxi, foot, bicycle, bus or in their own vehicle.

Whilst we will ensure that the bay is open for all to use, the Policy in place at Paspaley Plaza is that we will not tolerate drunken individuals, we will not tolerate anti-social behaviour and we will not tolerate taxi drivers, or any drivers, who have a pattern of erratic and unsafe driving behaviour.

Currently we do have a ban in place for [REDACTED] across all Paspaley Pearls properties in Broome. The decision to do this was decided over a period of time, with much thought and discussion. The ban on [REDACTED] [REDACTED] will remain in place until such time as that taxi company wish to discuss its removal, and how we can work together to improve overall safety standards.



I wish to note that if the relocation of the taxi rank within our premises does not work as we hope, we will remove it.
